Yearlong Classes: Students will get ONE class if they select a year long class

- **Beginning Band 6-8:** NO previous experience is necessary to enroll. There are a limited number of school instruments available. A minimum of two evening performances.
- **Advanced Band 7-8:** Prerequisite: Band Director's approval. A minimum of two evening performances.
- **Chorus:** Multi-grade level vocal music performance class. No experience necessary, just bring your desire to sing Pop, Broadway and Choral pieces. A minimum of two evening performances.

ASB 7/8-If you are interested in applying, pick-up an application from Mr. White in C-8. Students will be programmed upon acceptance.

Semester Classes: Students will get 2 classes if they select semester classes (Remember to rank classes 1-6)

- **Intro to Art 7/8-**This class is for students who have **NOT** taken Art at MCMS before; beginning painting and drawing.
- **Art II 7/8** – Prerequisite: *Intro to Art*: more advanced techniques of painting, drawing and other media.
- **Art Showcase 7/8** – Prerequisite: *Art II* and recommendation from teacher; MCMS's most advanced art class.
- **Computer Applications 7/8** –This course includes keyboarding, Internet and Microsoft Office Professional.
- **Advanced Computer 7/8** –Prerequisite: *Computers 7/8*: computer-based projects, using Word, Excel, and other programs.
- **Tech Investigations 7/8-**Students choose from a variety of multimedia components.
- **Dynamic Digital Media 7/8-** Students will be introduced to iMovie & Windows Movie Maker.
- **Drama 7/8** – This course will teach the students the fundamentals of the dramatic arts.
- **Intro to French 7/8** –An introductory course of the French language.
- **Intro to Spanish 7/8** – An introductory course of the Spanish language.
- **Panther Press 7/8** – Students will study the styles and structures of news reporting and writing and newspaper format.
- **Yearbook 7/8-** Students produce the MCMS yearbook: theme, layout, design, production.
