- 1. Discuss the need for friends, as well as the factors involved in choosing friends.

- 7. Be able to define and explain what *prejudice* is, provide some causes and effects of prejudice, and its relationship to stereotypes and roles.
- 8. Identify and discuss the factors involved in the communication process.
- 9. Explain the different types of persuasion processes.
- 10. Be able to define and meaningfully use the term *social norm*.
- 11. Analyze and be able to explain the aspects of group dynamics, including leadership styles and group behavior.
- 12. Identify and describe the factors that affect group conformity.
- 13. Be able to explain causes of group conflict and cooperation, as well as summarize how group dynamics promote or restrain altruism and aggression.
- 14. Define, and accurately apply terminology of "social psychology" including: *density, crowding, territory, privacy,* and *adaptation*.
- 15. Analyze how urban renewal can help solve urban problems, but also be able to address some of the problems of urban renewal, including the urban-overload hypothesis.
