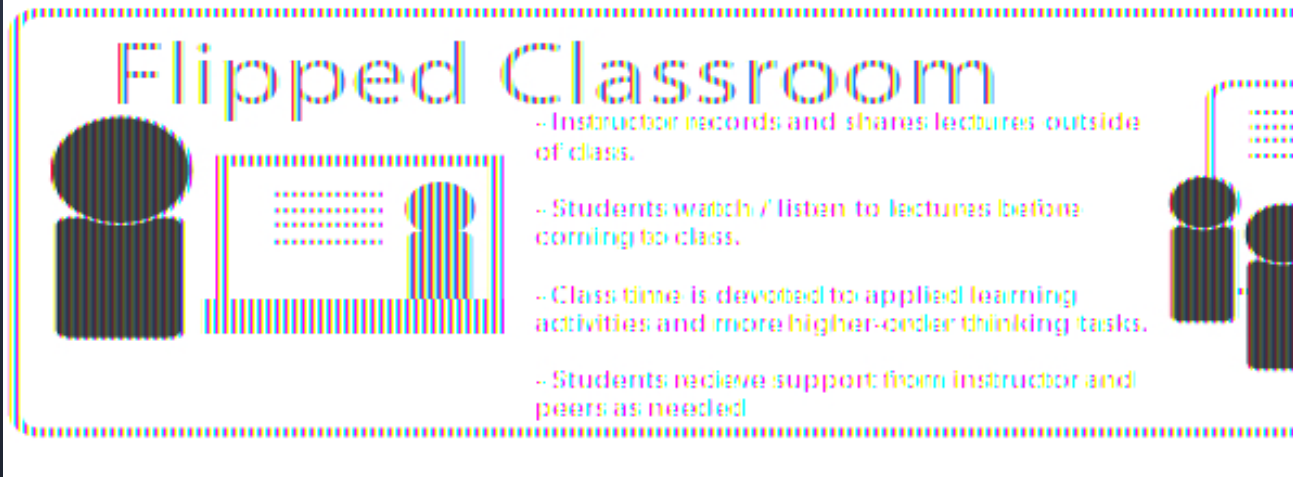
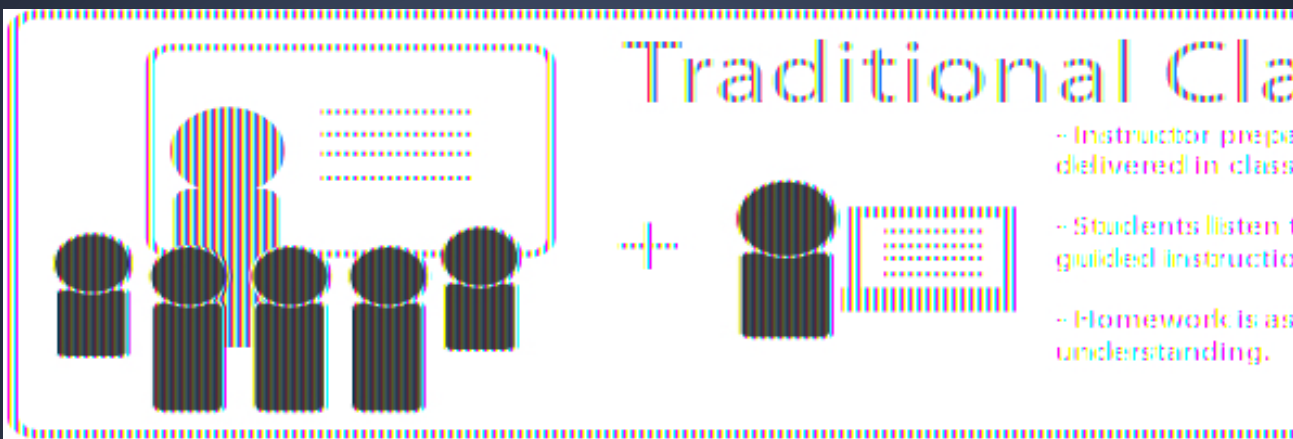

“Flipped Classroom”

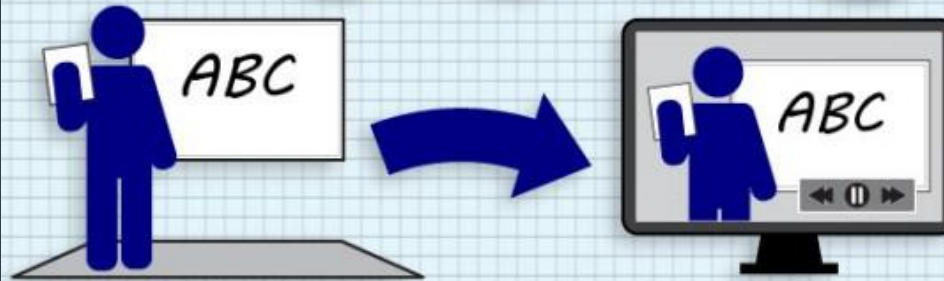
- ❖ Moves direct instruction from the group learning space to the individual learning space.
- ❖ Group learning space is now transformed into a dynamic, interactive learning environment with opportunities for project-based learning, application, and creativity.

Teacher Access

- ❖ Log in with OPUSD Google Account
- ❖ Create a class (Ex: Algebra II)
- ❖ Share class code with students to join
- ❖ Find and remix videos
- ❖ Assign video lessons
 - Option to include due date
 - Control whether or not students can skip ahead
- ❖ Share video lessons with colleagues and/or share URL link on website or Google classroom




Student Access

- ❖ Log in with OPUSD Google account
- ❖ Students enter code to join teacher's
- ❖ Student's dashboard:
 - Displays all enrolled EDpuzzle classes
 - Categorizes assignments: "Due Soon," "Upcoming," and "Archived"
- ❖ Students complete video lessons
- ❖ Free iOS app for students to access EDpuzzle from iPads or iPhones

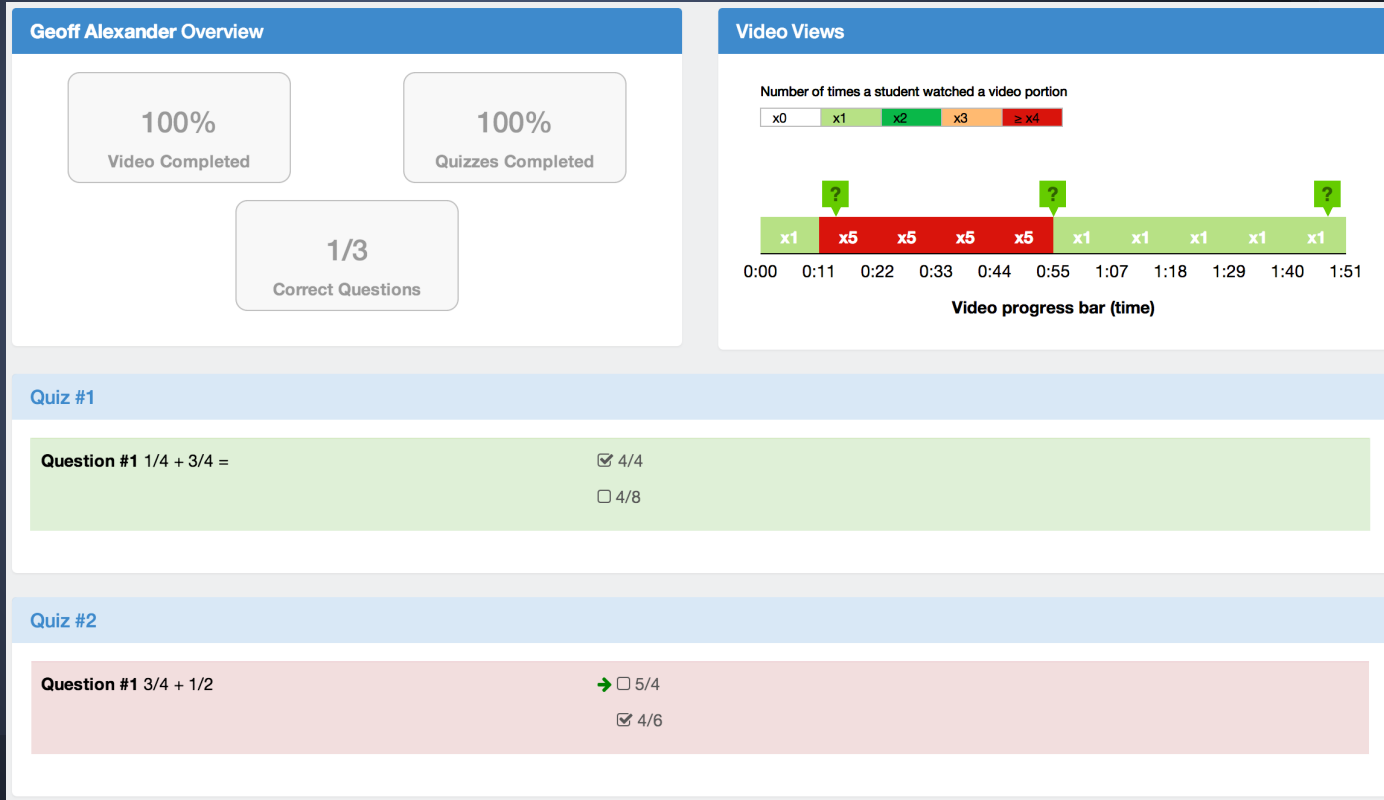
Monitor Individual Progress
