Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

- Bridge between preschool and Kindergarten
- Under California's Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) legislation, TK allows access to public school for all four-year-olds
 - Formerly known as "Discovery Kindergarten (DK)" in OPUSD
- Provides a 2-year Kindergarten program for all students
 - Four-year-olds attend TK
 - Five-year-olds attend K



Who is eligible to attend TK?

Students who turn 4 on or before September 1, 2023.



TK Program Overview

- 4 hours/day
- Developmentally appropriate materials and curriculum
- Taught by experienced, credentialed teachers
- 12:1 student-teacher ratio (1 teacher, 1 instructional aide)
- Elementary counselor and positive behavior support
- Collaboration and articulation between OPUSD preschool and TK teachers





TK focuses on...

- Students feeling safe and happy in a school environment
- Fostering a love of learning
- Play-based learning
- Learning-to-learn skills:
 - Routines and expectations
 - Cueing to teacher
 - Following directions
 - Making connections
 - Problem solving



Play-based Learning

Play is an important vehicle for developing self-regulation, as well as for promoting language, cognition, and social competence.




Early Academic Learning

- Language development
- Pre-literacy
 - Letters and sounds, concepts of print, vocabulary, etc.
- Pre-math
 - Counting, graphing, number ID, 1:1 correspondence, etc.
- Pre-writing
 - Holding a pencil, drawing, coloring, etc.
- Social Studies
- Science

- Elementary counselor and behavior specialists support
- Collaboration and articulation between OPUSD TK and K teachers




K focuses on...

K Curriculum











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Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS)

- Universally screen students 3x/year in early literacy and early math skills
- Trained interventionists work with students needing additional support in small group settings
- Progress monitoring provides data on the efficacy of the intervention and informs next steps
- Early intervention helps ensure a solid literacy and numeracy foundation
