### **DESCRIPTIONS**

#### High School Math Tutorial / Instructional Workshop

Open to all high school students enrolled in math. There is a strong focus on instruction in Pre-Algebra, Algebra, Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Finite and Math Analysis. Students should bring all math materials to class each week. **NCAA students must check in at one of these workshops each month.** 

#### Middle School Math Tutoring

Open to all students grades 6-8 interested in gathering with other students to study and work on their assignments.

# **High School Science Tutoring**

Individual and small-group drop in tutoring. Although open to all high school students, this tutoring focuses primarily on Chemistry.

## **High School Science Instructional Workshop**

Open to all high school students, this instructional workshop is designed to further develop scientific literacy and analytical thinking skills for students enrolled in: Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Psychology. Students will participate in a wide variety of individual and group activities to understand natural phenomena and explore how science works. As per the goals of the Next Generation Science Standards, emphasis will be on science and engineering practices, crosscutting concepts, disciplinary core ideas, and technological applications of scientific knowledge (STEM). NCAA students must check in at one of these workshops each month.

# H.S. Social Std. Workshop
