We will view a multimedia presentation on JPL entitled, "Journey to the Planets and Beyond", which provides an overview of the laboratory's activities and accomplishments. We will visit the Space Flight Operations Facility , the Spacecraft Assembly facility and the Karmon Visitor Center. The tour lasts between 2-2.5 hours.
