### Back to School Night is this Wednesday, August 16th!



#### **Basic Overview**

### Parking Reminders & Campus Safety

- Please allow plenty of time in the mornings and make sure to arrive early if you are parking and walking your student in.
- You may park in the areas marked on Satinwood and Conifer.
- The parking lot is reserved for Brookside teachers and staff ONLY
- Please do not park in the parking lot and observe all RESERVED parking signs and access signs.
- Please observe the Reserved parking signs for our PTA President, Auction Winner and Handicap Access drivers (please only use these spots when you have the affected person with you in the vehicle).
- Please do not park in the red marked lanes, next to fire hydrants or in front of our neighbors' mailboxes. Do not move trash cans on trash day.
- Use crosswalks as they have crossing guards.
- Observe "no parking" signs on the street, particularly near crosswalks; offenders are subject to ticketing.

### ParentSquare Registration

ParentSquare is the school & PTA's amazing communication system sponsored by the PTA and used by all classes and our PTA; it eliminate multiple platforms by centralizing all school-related communications, sign-ups, flyers, photos, calendars into one secure location. New families: please be sure you register when you receive the invitation sent by Principal Ahl via email! You may download the free ParentSquare app on your mobile app store or simply go into your web browser and add to your device's home screen. You will be placed into your classes and receive an invitation this week. Simply accept the invitation and set-up a password and click on "My Account" to change notification settings.

ParentSquare Directory: Please note we do NOT have a printed directory. Take a moment to click on your email in "My Account" to render it as visible; all emails are currently hidden. You must elect to have your email visible if you wish to have it visible in the ParentSquare directory.
