10/5 Oak Park CERT Training and Update

TIME CHANGE: FALL BACK NOVEMBER 1ST

Oak Park residents need to be prepared:

Spring and Fall time changes are great reminders for improving home and family safety.

- Smoke Detectors/Carbon Dioxide Detectors: Change Batteries! According to the U.S. Fire Administration, most alarms need a new battery at least once a year. In addition, if your wired smoke alarm is more than 10 years old, replace it with a new alarm and a new battery. Practice your fire escape plan.
- Fire Extinguishers: Check Status/Maintenance and Replace if needed
- Clothes Dryer & Vent: Clean accumulated lint
- Kitchen Hood Fan: Clean accumulated grease

- COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM
- Furnace/Air Conditioner Filters: Follow manufacturer's replacement schedule usually every 3-6 months
- Rain Gutters: Clean out debris. http://fire.countyofventura.org
- Water Filters: Follow manufacturer's replacement schedule
- Disaster Supplies: Rotate/Replace/Add to Water, Food, First Aid, Sheltering equipment and supplies.
- Add rain gear-battery powered radios-family communication plan. www.fema.org
