Notice of Law Enforcement Training

Event: A multi-agency training for emergency response for first responders

Date: Tuesday, May 30, 2023

Time: Approximately 8:30 am - 5:00 pm

Location: Oak Park High School, 899 Kanan Road, Oak Park, CA 91377

As part of the ongoing training for the case of an active assailant or other emergencies in our community or at one of our schools, the Ventura County Sheriff's Department is coordinating a multi-agency (adjacent County law enforcement, fire, paramedics, and school district) event that will take place at Oak Park High School on Tuesday, May 30. The training exercise is designed to gather first responders from different agencies to deliberate their role and response before,

during, and after an emergency. This multi-agency exercise will simulate an active assailant incident, aiming to ensure a coordinated, timely, and effective response and recovery in the event of a major incident.

Invited agencies will audit this event, but it is *not open to the public*. We are notifying the Oak Park and OPUSD community to prevent any concerns arising from the law enforcement presence and training drills on Tuesday.

Please note the following:

Oak Park High School will be closed off to all visitors and staff from 8:00 am until 6:00 pm, including all fields, unless specifically arranged with the school. Signs will be posted around the school on May 30 (training day) to inform and remind members of the public that the campus is closed for law enforcement training.

There will be a significant presence of emergency personnel and vehicles on and around the site.

Between **11:00 am and 5:00 pm**, “live” drills will take place that will have simulated gunfire (these will be paintball-type weapons). There will certainly be sounds such as “gunfire, ” shouting, and possibly sirens, which will all be part of the “live” simulation.
