## Oak Park High School 2016-17 AB 1012 Waiver Information and Consent Form

Assembly Bill No. 1012 was signed by the governor October 9, 2015 and begins with the 2016-17 school year. AB 1012 prohibits any student in grades 9-12 to be enrolled "in any course period without educational content". This includes late start/early dismissal and office aide.

However, AB 1012 also requires that pupil may be assigned to a course period without educational content. E.g. Office Aide, if the pupil's parent/guardian has consented in writing to the assignment." Or "a school official has determined that the pupil will benefit from being assigned to the course period." This includes late start/early dismissal and office aide.

## OPHS Late Start/Early Release and Study Hall Policy

Any junior or senior who wishes to take advantage of a Late Start/Early Dismissal or student who wishes to take a study Hall must be on track to graduate and have a surplus of credits that allows him or her to take a release period or enroll in study hall. Students must still be enrolled in at least five courses per semester.

- 1. Student must have parent permission.
- 2. Late Start/Early Dismissal is only offered for the first two or the last two periods of the school day.
- 3. Any senior who is placed in Credit Recovery or needs to complete core-subject requirements will have their Late Start/Early Dismissal Agreement forfeited.
- 4. Study Hall is offered only in periods 5 and 6, and is available to all grades.

## OPHS Office Aide Policy

Any senior who wishes to apply for an office aide position must:

- 1. Have outstanding attendance.
- 2. Have ability to keep information confidential.
- 3. Not use their cell phone while in the office.
