Freshmen Mentoring

- APCs go into P.E. classes once a month to teach a lesson
- Includes most of the freshmen class
- Large Outreach
- 1-10's

- Meaningful conversations

- Freshmen get to know upperclassmen

8th Grade Transition

- Occurs every spring
- Advanced Peer Counselors visit 8th graders at Medea Creek Middle School
- Answer questions about what high school is like
- Cover topics from academics \rightarrow 7th period \rightarrow clubs \rightarrow athletics
- Emphasize mutual experiences
- Help to reduce transitional stress


