Automatic Merit - automatically considered once accepted based on GPA/test scores.

Scholarship Application - usually based on GPA/ test scores and requires additional essay(s).

Application Deadlines

EDI or EDII - Early Decision is binding. May only apply to one and sign agreement.

REA - Restrictive Early Action - Non-binding but may only apply to one!

EA - Early Action - Non-binding and apply early and receive an early decision.

RD - Regular Decision - Apply by deadline and receive decision March/April.

Rolling - Apply and receive a decision as the class fills up and usually within 4-6 weeks.
