### Parent Recommendations

- Stay involved without hovering
- Have realistic expectations, articulate them, AND be there to support and encourage your student
  - Student buy-in into your expectations
  - Provide love and support:
    - Show you care
    - Volunteer whenever possible
    - Provide academic support
    - Accept that your child will have ups and downs
    - Make sure your student has some free time or down time

#### Parent Recommendations (Cont'd)

- Encourage independence
- Keep an open dialogue with your student
  - Create a comfortable, sharing environment
  - Provide feedback when appropriate
  - Your student's health and well-being comes first
- Know your student's school
  - Encourage students to reach out to Mrs. Friedman
  - Attend C&CC Information Nights/CKNs
  - Read the school's eNews, bulletins, and emails
- Be proud of your student's unique gifts
