



- Offer <u>Vocational Training</u>
- <u>Earlier Admissions Process</u>
 starts November May
- Plan to participate in an application workshop, English and Math assessment test
 Attend New Student Orientation



Private / Independent Colleges and Universities do NOT Charge In-state vs Out-of-State Tuition










Out of State - MORE Choices!

WUE - Western Undergraduate Exchange What is it?? Tuition Reduction!!

- Students in Western states may enroll in participating two-year and four-year public college programs at a reduced tuition level
- up to 150% of the institution's regular resident tuition
- WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition


