Students participating in TAG, will receive early review of their academic records, receive early admission notification and specific guidance about major preparation and general education coursework.

Keep in mind: TAG applications are due Sept. 30, but students can only apply for a TAG at one campus. To keep your options open, apply to other UC campuses during the regular application cycle (Nov. 1-30). Students are also able to use the [UC Transfer Admission Planner](#) to track their progress in meeting UC's minimum requirements.

 2. Attendance at mandatory Honors orientation.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

What is General Population Dual Enrollment?

K-12 students who choose to take a Moorpark College course offered on the college campus are considered General Population Dual Enrollment students. They find a course that they are interested in taking in our [Schedule of Classes](#), discuss it with their high school counselor, and follow the enrollment steps to register. The students will be in the course of their choice alongside other Moorpark College students.



What is the Dual Enrollment Program?

Our Dual Enrollment department works with the local high school districts and staff to decide on Moorpark College courses to offer *at the high school*, specifically for that high school's students. So instead of having K-12 students travel to the college to take a course, we bring the college courses to the high school. This means that we must have a minimum of 30 students interested to be able to offer one of these courses. They are filled with only high school students, meaning your classmates will be your high school peers. We do not publish our courses online in the Schedule of Classes because they are reserved for our program's students only. The high school campus informs the students of the courses that will be offered at their high school each semester.

OpenCCC is a service of the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office. The information in your account is kept private and secure.

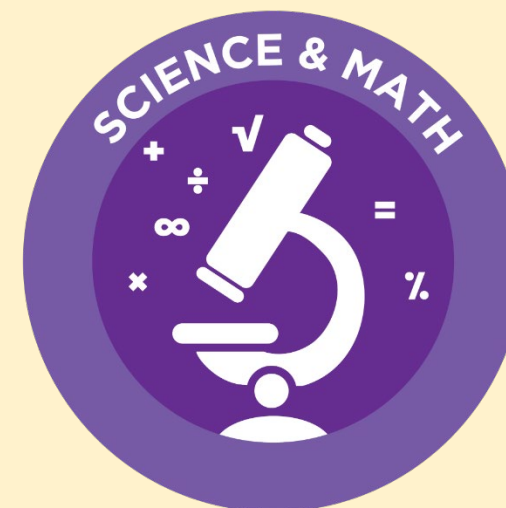

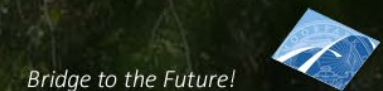

Assistance With Academic Standing

This channel provides guidance and understanding about a student's academic standing. Academic standing relates to how a student is progressing with their course work.

There are three types of academic standing:

1. Good standing – means student has at least a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) and is completing most of the classes attempted.
2. Progress Probation – means a student has not successfully completed at least half of the total units attempted. "Successful completion" means passing the class with a grade of C/P or better.
3. Academic Probation – means a student has a GPA lower than 2.0.

[Probation/Dismissal](#)

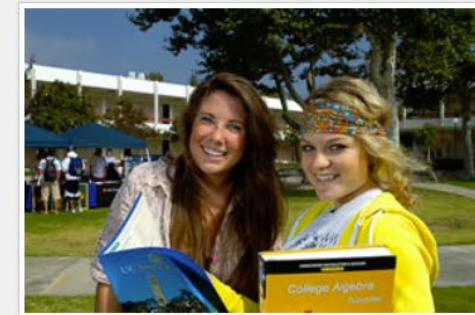
Students are dismissed or placed on probation for "insufficient progress" which results from too many withdrawals or substandard grades. Probation and Dismissal status restricts the number of units in which a student can enroll. If you receive notification that your status is Probation or Dismissal, contact the Counseling Office to discuss your academic standing and your options for improving your standing, increasing your enrollment limit, or requesting readmission. Probation, dismissal, and readmission procedures are in place to assure that students make progress toward their educational goals and are discussed in greater detail in the college catalog.
