



COLLEGE APPLICATION & MATRICULATION STATISTICS (2012-2019)

This annual survey is taken just prior to graduation by all OPHS Seniors. It is primarily a self-reporting survey done to provide a picture of what our graduates will be doing after high school. It has been established to be an accurate picture of the college plans of a graduating class, as well as providing the average academic profile of OPHS students who were admitted to specific colleges and universities. Naviance has collected OPHS college admission data dating back to the class of 2009 and is posted below. 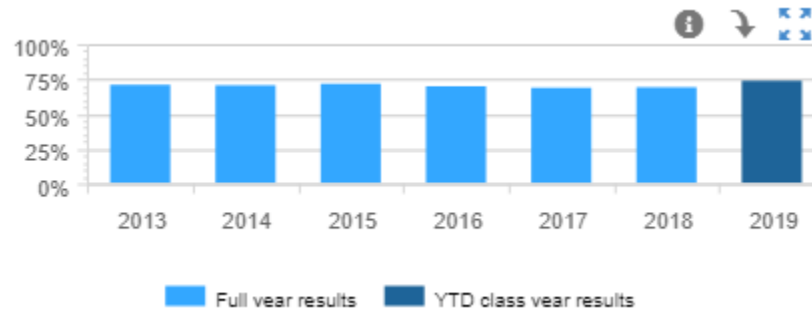

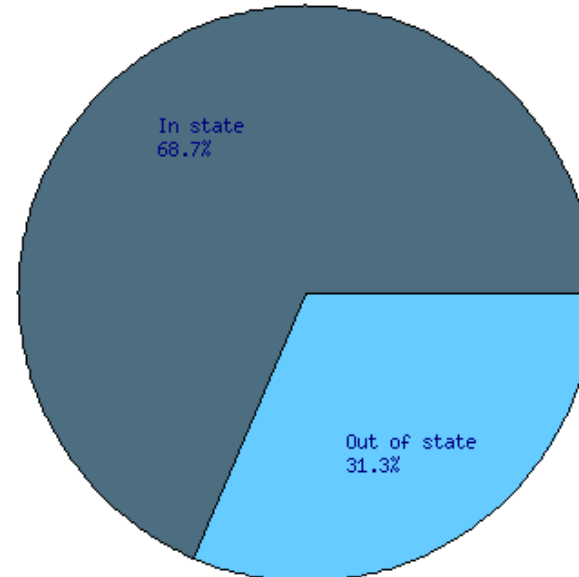
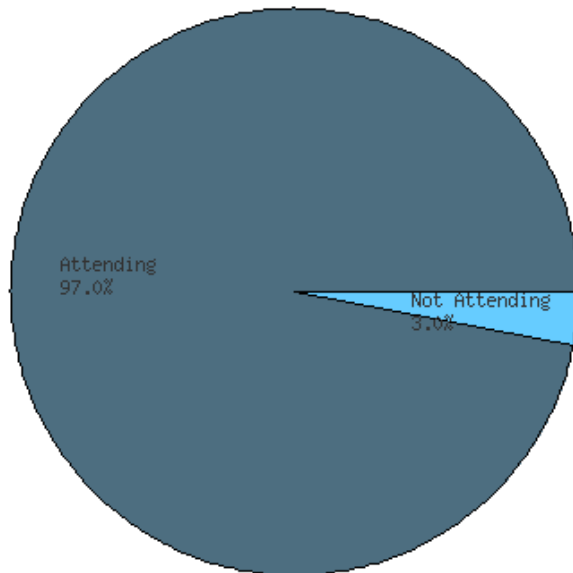


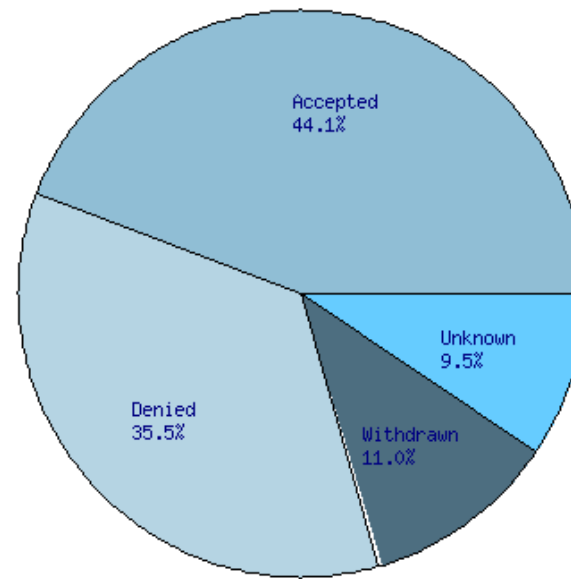
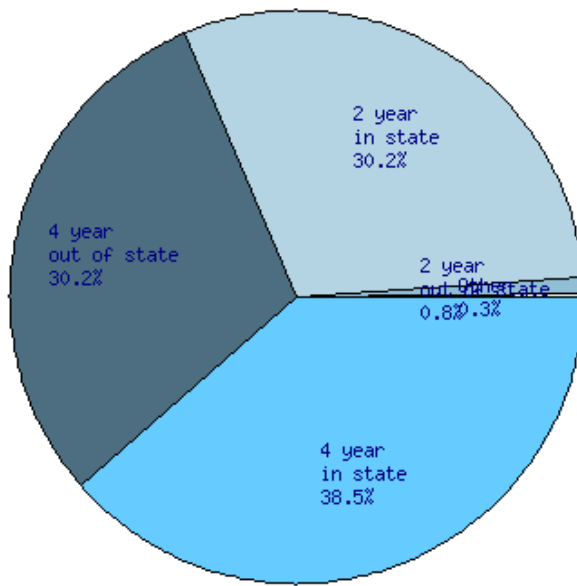


The Oak Park Class of 2019 received tremendous recognition from colleges and universities throughout the country! In an exit survey administered to our **369** graduating seniors, the following statistics were collected. Column abbreviations break out the data as follows: **Accepted** = the number of Oak Park seniors who reported that they were accepted by this school; **Attending**= the number of seniors who reported that they have committed to attend this school; **Average AP/C/H** = the average number of AP, College and Honors courses taken by the student(s) who have committed to attend this school. **Average Unweighted GPA** = the average unweighted GPA of those seniors who have committed to attend this school. Or, if none of our students have committed to attend this school, this will be the average unweighted GPA of all admitted students. **Average UC/CSU Weighted GPA** = the average weighted GPA according the UC/CSU GPA formula. **Average SAT or ACT** = the average SAT or ACT of those seniors who have committed to attend this school. When you see a “-“ it means that we have no data (current or historical) to report for this field.

Denied = the number of Oak Park Seniors who reported that they applied and were denied by this school. For schools where there were no students accepted **Average AP/C/H** = the average number of AP, College and Honors courses taken by the student(s) who were denied by this school. For schools where there were no students accepted **Average SAT or ACT** = the average SAT or ACT of those seniors who were denied by this school. For schools where there were no students accepted **Average Unweighted GPA** = the average unweighted GPA of those seniors who were denied by this school.

Note: if none of the admitted or denied students for a particular school has taken an SAT or ACT test this year. The SAT/ACT score quoted is the average of OPHS students admitted to that school from the last three years.
