Steps to Applying to a 4 Year College

- 1. Refer to <u>Applying to College Checklist</u> mailed home
- 2. <u>Naviance</u> update student email, complete tasks assigned
- 3. <u>Finalize College List</u> with Correct Deadlines "Colleges
- I'm Applying To"
- 4. Seniors sign up for <u>1:1 Counselor Appointment</u> through Calendy on Counselor Staff page.
- 5. <u>Letters of Recommendation</u> Ask teacher , then Requests made thru Naviance <u>NOT</u> Common App!
- 6. <u>Transcript Request</u> Use school electronic form, do <u>NOT</u> request through Naviance, pay at student store online





Early Decision (ED) Important to Understand

- 1. You may only apply to 1 ED college! (you can apply EA to other schools but not Restrictive EA). Check each college ED policy.
- 2. Student, parents and your OPHS counselor sign an ED acknowledgment agreement!
- 3. **ED is binding.** If accepted you are agreeing to attend this school (Consider finances before applying).
- 4. You must withdraw your applications from all other colleges if accepted ED!
- 5. Mid year transcripts will **not** be sent to other colleges if you are accepted ED.
- 6. If a college does not offer the financial package you were expecting you may withdraw from the college ED acceptance *(but first speak to admissions office and financial aid office).*

- Other some Universities have their own application on their website. If they also use the Common Application, choose that instead.


Common Application

- If you opened your account prior to August 1st you must **ROLLOVER**
- School Report counselor will send with your transcript automatically when requested
- Recommenders Note "Required" and "Optional"
 *DO NOT ASSIGN OPHS teachers/counselor as recommenders thru the Common App (see later slide for more info)
- **Essays** Choose one Common App, but each school may have additional supplemental essays
- **Official Test Scores** Sent by Student Separately
- **Transcripts** Initial, Midyear, and Final
- **Deadlines** These vary, check by school

Matching Your Common App with Naviance

In order for OPHS to be able to submit transcripts and/or recommendations to your Common Application you must "match" these two programs.

TIPS

These tips will help you successfully match your accounts.

- Mark sure you use the email address that you chose for your Common App account
- Make sure that last name on your Naviance Student account matches the last name you used to create your Common App account.
- Make sure the date of birth on your Naviance Student account matches the date of birth on your Common App account.


Common App FERPA

1. How does FERPA relate to your college application?

- FERPA regulates the privacy of student education records, which could include your application to the college where you enroll. FERPA also gives you the right to review confidential letters of recommendation provided as part of that application after you enroll.
- 2. In a moment, you'll be asked if you want to waive the right to review confidential letters of recommendation. What should you know about this waiver?
 - Waiving your right lets colleges know that you do not intend to read your recommendations, which helps reassure colleges that the letters are candid and truthful.
 - Some recommenders may decline to write a letter for you if you do not waive your rights. Check with your counselor or teachers to see if any of them follow such a policy.
 OPHS follows this policy

Common App - FERPA

- Once a school is added, sign FERPA release, then it applies to all schools in your "My Colleges" list
- Remember do <u>NOT</u> invite teacher recommendations here!



Coalition App

Do NOT request teacher/counselor LORs through the Coalition App.

If using the Coalition App, OPHS uses Naviance for document submission. Be sure to select "Direct to Institution" in Naviance in the "I'll submit my application" section.

California State University

- Student sets up a CSU portal and check status
- **VISIT THIS LINK** to read more about your CSU eligibility
- ACT and SAT (temporarily suspended the use of ACT/SAT exams)
- Oct 1 Nov 30

- NO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION or INITIAL
 TRANSCRIPTS
 - Order Mid Year Transcript (<u>only</u> if CSU requests it)

University of California

- Comprehensive Review
- 4 of 8 personal insight questions (350 words each)
- Send official test scores from testing sites (all UCs are test optional - double check specialized and competitive majors)
- Application filing period Nov 1-Nov 30
- UC Application Llnk
- <u>NO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION or INITIAL TRANSCRIPTS</u>
 - Any requests for additional information will be done after submission of your application from a link sent from the college with instructions

Letters of Recommendation

- Ask your teacher directly first (email ok). If you don't get a clear yes, find another teacher.
- Once a YES is received, then you will add that teacher to Naviance.
 - **DO NOT select "All Colleges**" in Naviance. Select each college separately that will accept a letter.
- 3) Follow up with a thank you timed nicely when sharing news about college decisions!

Letters of Recommendation

DO <u>NOT</u> assign recommenders on the Common App for OPHS teachers/staff.

We use Naviance to send recommendation letters to Common App schools. If you invite the teacher from the Common App and they accept accept it will block their letter from ALL STUDENTS at OPHS - **DON'T DO THAT.**

No letters for UC's or CSU's (unless requested and sent a link with instructions)

Letter of Recommendation DEADLINE

Three weeks advance notice is required for a letter of recommendation. The deadline to request a letter of recommendation is *Friday, November 20th* for any colleges with deadlines prior to Jan 15.

Do not request a letter unless you are certain you need one. Much time/effort is put into each letter. It is your responsibility to look up this information on the

college website or you can check through the Common App.

Some colleges do <u>NOT</u> require a letter of recommendation.

Required Counselor Meeting

By October 31: Go to your counselor's staff page to sign up for your 1:1 meeting. *Meetings are for students only*.

If you are doing an EARLY Action/Decision deadline or are submitting a rolling application early, your scheduled appointment needs to be <u>3 weeks</u> prior to your deadline. Otherwise, DO NOT sign up that early.

If you do not have your required Naviance tasks complete by scheduled appointment date, your appointment will be canceled and rescheduled to a later date.

What to know about Private College Counselors

- Should have a College Counseling Certificate.
- PCC should not use phrases like "I can get you in" and should not take any credit for doing so.
- PCC must follow the OPHS protocol. Always check with your High School Counselor about important questions.
- Ask for references. Contact past clients.
- Utilize FREE help College and Career Night, Essay Writing Workshop, College Fairs, Virtual Reps visiting OPHS, College and Career Advisor - Julie Prince, OPHS counselors.
- Colleges will only accept a letter of recommendation from your high school counselor.

FAFSA Facts – Need Based Aid

- FAFSA Free Application for Federal Student Aid FAFSA
- FAFSA uses your taxes from previous years.
- Financial aid may bring the cost down depending on income, family size and the number of children attending college simultaneously.
- Estimate your need based aid with <u>FAFSA 4caster</u> BEFORE applying

Need based vs. Merit based

- **Need** is based on your financial situation, cost of college, # of siblings in college, family size, age of parents, income, savings, (not IRA's).
- **Merit** is based on your grades, SAT and ACT scores (check with college to see if test scores are needed)
- If you are a top student in the pool you will be awarded aid. If you are like all the other applicants, don't count on it. To get Merit Aid, go to the school where you are at the top of the applicant pool.



- An <u>electronic</u> form for transcript requests is <u>available on</u> your counselors staff page or <u>HERE</u>
- Initial Transcript transcript includes grades 9-11.
- <u>Mid Year or 7th semester</u> your grades through first semester of senior year.
- <u>Final transcript</u> ordered in the last week of school includes 9-12 grade.
- Pay for your transcripts at the online Student Store. \$5 per college. Every student will be mailed 1 FREE unofficial transcript with directions on how to order more.
