### **Overview of qualifying conditions**

**40** - Students with one or more learning disabilities as their qualifying conditions (i.e. ADHD, processing disorder(s), dysgraphia etc.)

**17**- Students with medical issues as their qualifying conditions (i.e. Diabetes, Juvenile arthritis, allergies, GERD, Chronic Kidney disease, Connective tissue disease, vision and hearing impairments).

**14** - Students with Generalized Anxiety Disorder, Depression, Anorexia, OCD and/or Panic Disorder as one (or more) of their qualifying conditions.

### **Most common accommodations**

**44** – Students with preferential seating accommodations

**36** - Students with extended time on testing accommodations

**28** – Students with supplemental notes accommodations

**27** - Students who require help with organization as an accommodation

**20** - Students with teacher checks for understanding, cueing for on task behavior, and/or positive reinforcement accommodations

**20** - Reduction in homework as an accommodation

**15** – Students with a Directed Studies class
