### "Topic 4: Competition and Market Structures"

- 1. How does competition affect markets?
- Perfect competition exists when a market has many buyers and sellers of the same good so that no one buyer or seller can affect the price.
- 3. Monopolies exist when one seller controls a market. Monopolies are so powerful that the government strictly regulates them.
- 4. Monopolistic competition is similar to perfect competition, except the goods are not identical and firms have a small amount of control over prices.
- 5. An oligopoly is a market made up of only a few large producers who have some control over the pricing of the goods they sell.

#### "Topic 5: Business and Labor"

- 1. How can businesses and labor best achieve their goals?
- 2. In a sole proprietorship, one owner makes all the decisions and profits while accepting all the responsibilities and debts. In partnerships, two or more owners share the benefits and responsibilities.
- A corporation is owned by its stockholders and run by professional managers.
- 4. Nonprofit organizations function like businesses, but do not operate for the purpose of generating profit.
- 5. The labor market changes over time as the types of jobs available to workers change and as the composition of the labor force changes.
- 6. Unions arose during the days of the Industrial Revolution and fought to improve working conditions, wages, and benefits.
