

Reading a Diagram

Directions: Study the diagram below of the earth's landforms and water bodies. Then write the correct land or water feature next to each description.



1. a narrow waterway connecting two larger bodies of water
2. a broad and flat or gently rolling area where there are few changes in the landscape
3. a stretch of low land lying between hills or mountains and usually having a river or stream flowing through it
4. a long, narrow valley between high cliffs, often with a stream flowing through it
5. a natural stream of water larger than a creek and emptying into an ocean, lake, or **sea**.
6. a land area almost entirely surrounded by water
7. a deposit of sand and soil, usually triangular, formed at the mouth of some rivers
8. a landmass, not as large as a continent, surrounded by water
9. an inland body of water, usually freshwater, larger than a pool or pond
10. a group or chain of islands
