#### 7th Period - Student Support Period




## College Entrance Exams

- PFA boot camp and Mock Exams



- Attend 7<sup>th</sup> period support regularly




# The Curve of Forgetting




This graph shows how information is lost over time, when there is no attempt to retain it.


