 - ex. AHS, WHS, or Oak Park Residents (use Google Maps and clustering method)
- 1. Eliminate fears at the top (3 lines)
 - a. confidential/anonymous → in bag (if online, picture of a bag at the top of the survey or email)
 - b. incentive (be original)
- 2. 15 questions $(+_2)$ (12 < # of questions < 20)
- 3. Read class notes to write survey
- 4. Look at tutorials (Micek's website)
- 5. Review <u>3 repairs</u> of Student Opinion Poll HW
- 6. Read past projects (90+%)
- 7. Work together on everything!
- 8. Second draft of survey
- 9. 5 harsh peer reviews (P.0, 1, 4, 5, past students)
- 10. Rough draft #3
 - a. Do not ask gender/grade ... (you already know)
 - b. "9F" or "12M" on back bottom of survey
 - c. Build trust (1. easy, 2. fun, 3. trust) but do not save big? for last (question 12 or 13 might be good)
- 11. Check with 2 statistics gurus (names, dates, times, notes and comments)
- 12. Rough draft #4

- 13. Take it for a Test Drive! Practice approach all group members...with clipboard, lab coat, SCRIPT, incentive, and Bag! 12 practice survey approaches...convenience sampling ok here...(if everybody gives the same answers → there may be bias in your questions, order of questions, or approach). Do this step 2-3 days before it's due, so you can make thoughtful, authentic reflections and adjustments. During class on the day it's due is NOT appropriate!
- 14. Rough draft #5
- 15. OPTIONAL ask The Sultan of Statistics (don't ask too late, like the Friday before it's due)
