

Dear Matt Micek:

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is participating in a statewide study of single family water use. The information gathered in this study will be used to assist water supply and water conservation planning throughout the state. We are hoping that you will agree to participate in this study. Your name was randomly selected from over 400,000 single family accounts to receive this invitation. All of the data gathered as part of the study will be kept confidential, and the results will only be published in aggregate form. Your name and utility usage will not be publicized.

If you agree to participate in this important research effort, all you (the LADWP customer of record) need to do is to fill out the attached survey, sign this letter in the space provided and mail this letter and the completed survey in the enclosed postage-paid return-addressed envelope. To thank you for your assistance, we will mail a Water Conservation Kit after the study concludes (approximately 2 months from today), which includes a showerhead, kitchen and bathroom faucet aerators, and toilet dye tablets (to check for leaks in your toilet[s]). As with all qualified program participants, a technician from the project consulting firm, Aquacraft, Inc., will visit your residence and install a data logger on your water meter. The data logger will be left on the meter for two weeks in order to provide us with detailed information about the water use patterns of your home. The technician will return to pick-up the logger and also perform a quick visual inspection of your landscape to verify information on plant types and areas obtained from aerial photo analysis. The technician will first knock on your door to ask permission to look at your yard and, if you are home, might ask you a couple of follow-up questions concerning your completed survey. That is all that is required.
