

MCMS Dance Policies and Procedures 2021-22

- 10/29/21 6th grade: 5:30-7:30, 7th/8th grade: 6:00-8:00
- Students must arrive in the first 30 minutes. No students will be admitted after the first 30 minutes.
- MCMS dances are for MCMS students only (OPIS Students are allowed with prior approval from the school).
- All students who wish to attend must present their ID card at the door and have a negative COVID test completed on campus 10/25 or 10/26, must bring in proof of their negative covid test off campus 10/25-10/28, or must be exempt from testing as per the district nurse.
- Admission to the dance is \$5 or free with a PAC card.
- The MCMS dress code will be strictly enforced. Clothing must cover the chest, back, buttocks, and torso. No backless shoes, strapless clothing, sagging pants or extremely short dresses or skirts! Costumes may be worn, but no masks which cover the entire face.
- During the dance, students must remain in designated areas. No students are to leave the dance area and go to out-of-bound areas (the entire dance set-up will be outside). Masks are encouraged at all times.
- Students may not leave the dance early without a parent/guardian meeting the student at the door.
- Parents must send a permission note to have their child picked up by another parent. This note needs to be turned in at the door upon admittance.
- All school conduct rules apply at school-sponsored events. All students must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner during the dance. Appropriate dancing is acceptable but 'grinding', inappropriate contact, touching, or gestures are grounds for student removal from the dance.
