





In August 2013, the Kanan Shuttle became operational, compliments of the County of Ventura. The shuttle has proven to be extremely beneficial to students attending Oak Park High School and Medea Creek Middle School, as well as the residents along Kanan Road. The use of the shuttle has remained complimentary, making it extremely popular among the youth of the community.

While shuttle activity has been primarily positive, there have been some reports of bullying and verbal harassment. It is the goal of the Oak Park Unified School District, The Ventura County Sheriff's Office and the Ventura County Transportation Department for all riders of the Kanan Shuttle to have a safe and positive riding experience. As such, we believe it is important to remind potential riders and their parents of the Kanan Shuttle Passenger Code of Conduct listed below.

Passengers engaging in the behaviors listed below will be subject to suspension of their riding privileges, citation or arrest:

- Threats of harm, assault or battery on driver or passengers
- Verbal abuse or harassment including the use of profanity
- Intimidation or altercation with driver or passengers
- Failure to obey a driver's instructions
- Damage to vehicle or equipment
- Repeated violation of riding rules
- Failure to maintain reasonable personal hygiene which may expose driver and passengers to health and safety risks
- Criminal conduct prohibited by the California Penal Code

Students utilizing the shuttle going to and from school may be additionally subject to school discipline for violation of the conduct rules.
