BACKGROUND:		In 2010, the Board authorized a contract for architectural services with KPI Architects in connection with Measure R projects, including the modernization projects at Oak Park School. District staff, in consultation with the Facility Planning Committee subcommittee and construction manager Balfour Beatty (BBC), is directing KPI in its finalization of plans for the Building A (Gymnasium) modernization project, which is slated for construction in 2014. It has been determined that the existing boiler system serving all of the locker rooms is at the end of its useful life. As this was not included in the original project scope, KPI has been asked to provide a proposal to design a replacement system. The proposal is attached for the Board's review, with a not-to-exceed cost of \$6,960.00. District staff, BBC, and the Facility Planning Committee, has reviewed the proposal and it is recommended that the Board approve the additional services, to be funded from State Modernization and Measure R Bond funds.
