ISSUE: Should the Board of Education expel student in Disciplinary Case #02-09-10

BACKGROUND: On November 16, 2015, an Oak View High School student was in violation of Education Codes 48900(b) possession of a knife, or other dangerous object of no reasonable use to the pupil. As required by Education Code 48915, the principal has recommended expulsion of this student.

A meeting was held with the parent on November 30, 2015 to review the incident, the suspension, and the recommendation for expulsion. After this meeting, the principal has recommended expulsion of this student with an alternative education placement.

CONSENT

ISSUE: Shall the Board deny Claim No. 15-04 and Claim No. 15-05, both for damages alleged against the District, pursuant to Government Code Sections 910-913.2?

BACKGROUND: On November 5, 2015, the District received two claims submitted by a parent on behalf of his high school student and by the parent on behalf of himself, alleging damages arising out of an incident that occurred at Oak Park High School on May 21, 2015. Details of this claim have been provided to the Board under separate cover.

As a matter of routine, it is recommended that the Board deny the claim as presented. Upon the Board’s denial of the claim, the matter will be referred to the District’s third party administrator for property and liability insurance, York Risk Services Group, Inc. Upon receipt, York Risk Services Group will investigate the merits of the claim and advise the District of further action, if any, as appropriate.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Reject Claim No. 15-04 and Claim No. 15-05 for alleged damages pursuant to Government Code Sections 910-913.2, and refer to the District’s third party administrator for further action.
2. Accept the claim for damages.

RECOMMENDATION: Alternative No. 1

SUBJECT: B.3.e. APPROVE CONTRACT FOR NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENT #06-15/16- \$33,694.58

ACTION

ISSUE: Should the Board of Education approve this contract for non-public school for this student?

BACKGROUND: This eight-year-old, third grade special education student was placed at The Help Group. Village Glen Non-Public (HELP Group) is a certified non-public school and has a Master contract with Ventura County SELPA. The cost of this placement is \$33,694.58; this includes tuition, speech & language therapy, counseling and occupational therapy. The District will receive an estimated \$7250.00 in revenue limit funds for students in grades K-5 to reduce the actual cost to \$26,444.58.

- 1) Fund this non-public school placement.
 - 2) Do not fund this non-public school placement.

RECOMMENDATION: Alternative #1

RATIONALE: The District is required by law to provide the services stated on a student’s IEP. The H.E.L.P. Group—Village Glen School is a certified non-public school.
