Policy revised to expand criteria for determining when instructional materials are obsolete or unusable, including adding nonalignment with district's academic standards or course of study.

b. Approve Amendment to Board Policy 3280 – Sale or Lease of District-Owned Real Property – First Reading

Policy revised to reflect new law (ABX4 2) which authorizes districts, until January 2, 2012, to use the proceeds from the sale of surplus property for any one-time general fund purpose.

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- **c.** Approve Amendment to Board Policy 3580 District Records First Reading 71 *Policy revised to reflect new law (AB5) which creates the California Electronic Discovery Act) to make the procedural rules requiring disclosure of documents to the opposing party in litigation applicable to electronically stored information. Policy directs Superintendent to consult with staff to create a document management system which includes a process for the storage and destruction of electronic materials, including a response to "litigation hold" requests.*
