Student Driving and Parking

The Governing Board recognizes that the general land use plan of Oak Park, as prepared by the Metropolitan Development Corporation, has placed the high school campus within 15 minutes walking distance of all residents, students are encouraged to walk or ride bicycles to school.

In order to implement a policy on student driving and parking, the administration is directed to do the following:

1. Local public use facilities (e.g. football field, little theater) in areas where both school and non-school parking will be available to participants.
2. Establish regulations regarding the use of motor vehicles by students for home-to-school transportation.
3. Provide an area for parking and locking student bicycles.
4. Provide appropriate pedestrian access to the school from all areas of the community.
