



NOTES FROM SCHOOL BOARD MEETING December 8, 2015

Educating Compassionate and Creative Global Citizens

At the organizational meeting of the Oak Park USD Board of Education held on December 8th, the Board heard reports from School Board Members, the Student Board Representative, the Superintendent, the Facilities Planning Committee and the Technology Department. The Board also heard a report from Oak Park High School Site Council. The Board presented a Certificate of Recognition to Ruitao Zhang for his participation in the All National Honor Concert Band, presented Partner in Education Awards to Mike Paule and Lori Getz and honored Pat Ramirez on her retirement from OPUSD.

- Approved Proposed Board Meeting Schedule for Calendar year 2016, changing Board Study Session to May 31, 2016 and Regular Meeting in June to June 14, 2016 – moving both of these meetings one week earlier due to the new school calendar.
- Approved Certification of Signatures.
- Approved the appointment of Denise Helfstein as the School Board Representative to the County Committee on School District Reorganization.
- Approved the Designation of Dr. Knight as Secretary/Authorized Agent of the Board of Education.
