ISSUE:		Should the Board approve a proposal allowing Oak Hills Elementary School to bank student time in order to add time for collaboration, instructional planning time and conferences?						
BACKGROUND:		Historically, collaboration and planning time for teachers at Oak Hills Elementary School was accomplished by funding from PTA for certificated music and physical education staff. This allowed classroom teachers necessary time during the school day to meet in grade level teams or plan individually. This plan was approved yearly through an MOU signed by OPTA. This year, OPTA did not sign the MOU and asked teachers to bank time, instead. The attached plan is the staff and parents' plan as requested.

# Banking Student Instructional Time In Order to Add Time for Collaboration, **Instructional Planning & Conferences**

A Proposal for 2012 – 2013

This proposal has been developed and discussed by the Oak Hills Elementary School Instructional Leadership Team, teaching staff, and principal. According to the OPTA/OPUSD Agreement, this constitutes a variance and the teachers at Oak Hills must approve this by a vote of 75% positive. If so approved, the plan is implemented in the January 2013.

In recognition of the professionalism of all participants, the provisions are as follows: Banking time within the instruction day will add planning time for teachers as outlined in the attached schedule.

- 1. The day will be Friday each week.
- 2. The goals of this plan are to further:
  - Differentiated Instruction
    - > Intervention
    - > Remediation
    - > Extension
    - > Acceleration
  - Fluid and Flexible Grouping
  - ❖ Data Analysis (interim assessment date, student work, etc.)
  - Cross Grade Level Collaboration
  - Curriculum planning
- 3. The minimum day afternoons each month will be scheduled as follows:

1st Week Grade level collaboration

2<sup>nd</sup> Week Regular monthly staff meeting from 1:30-3:00.

3<sup>rd</sup> Week Individual and/or Group Planning-group planning should be mutually agreed upon by all teachers at grade level by a simple majority.

4th Week Individual and/or Group Planning-group planning should be mutually agreed upon by all teachers at grade level by a simple majority.

- \* This schedule shall not be changed unless approved by a simple majority of teachers.
  - 4. On minimum days the professional responsibilities of teachers will end at the same time as on a full instructional day.

The section titled "Working Hours Defined" in Article 11 of the OPTA Contract states the following: Teachers, and other bargaining unit members, as professional, observe professional working hours. Teachers will be on site at least fifteen (15) minutes prior to the start of the student day and shall be available at those sites after school so as to provide reasonable time to meet with parents and to assist students.

During fall and spring conference weeks teachers may develop a schedule that meets their needs as well as the needs of parents. Teachers may leave campus when their professional responsibilities are finished.

- 5. **Minimum day afternoons** will **NOT** be used for staff development unless so requested or approved by the teachers. Approval will be 51%.
- 6. Teachers have a 45-minute lunch period on minimum days. Leaving campus is acceptable within that time frame.
- 7. The following days are **Special Minimum Days**; teachers are not expected to remain on campus after students are dismissed:

\*The last day of school See Attached Calendar for all Minimum Days

\* This variance will be reviewed should (furlough days) be necessary in the 2012/2013 school year.
