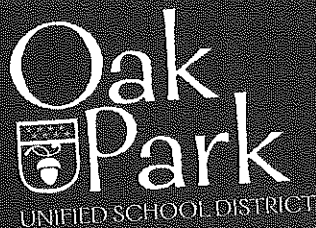

Subj: District of Choice Information

The District of Choice Legislation (SB 680) requires that all districts that have adopted a board resolution agreeing to the terms of the reauthorized law communicate to its geographically adjacent districts certain information related to District of Choice transfers.

Specifically, a district is required to report by May 15<sup>th</sup> of each year the following information:

- Number of requests granted, denied or withdrawn, including reasons for denial
- Number of students transferred into and out of the district
- Race, ethnicity, gender, socioeconomic status and district of residence for the students transferring into and out of the district
- Number of students transferring into and out of the district classified as English Learners and identified as individuals with exceptional needs

The enclosed information will provide you with the statistics on students from adjacent districts who have been accepted into Oak Park for the upcoming school year as the result of a District of Choice permit. While we have been careful to identify and pull out those students who have changed their minds since they were accepted into Oak Park Unified, it is possible that a few of the students in our numbers may elect to remain in their home district.

For your information Oak Park Unified will accept applications for District of Choice transfers for the 2012-2013 school year beginning November 1, 2011 and ending on December 31, 2011. Next year at this time we will forward to you the updated information on any additional transfers for the 2012-2013 school year.

Please be aware that any requests for an interdistrict transfer into Oak Park after the December 31 deadline has passed will always be routed back to the resident district and handled as a request under the provisions of Education Code 46600. In other words, these requests will not be accepted into Oak Park for the next school year without a release from the resident district.

Finally, know that Oak Park will always honor any requests from our local residents who may desire to attend a school in any of our neighboring districts. We have been consistent in our approval of these requests over the past years and will continue to follow that policy.
