- **BACKGROUND:** At its meeting on January 21, 2014, the Board approved the Measure R Master Plan 2014 Update, which added the priority replacement of Oak Park High School classrooms R1 through R6, all at the end of their serviceable life. At its February meeting, the Board authorized staff to move forward the lease-lease back acquisition of replacement buildings. # SUBJECT:2.APPROVE OF AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH<br/>VCEDNET FOR INTERNET CONNECTIVITY SERVICES

ACTION

- **ISSUE:** Shall the Board approve an amendment to the agreement with VCEDNET to increase internet connectivity services?
- **BACKGROUND:** At its meeting February 21, 2012, the Board approved a three-year contract with VCEDNET for internet connectivity services for all District schools and departments. The current contract with VCEDNET provides an option to increase bandwidth. With the upgrades in the network and increased number of users, the Educational Technology department is requesting the Board's authorization to exercise this option, increasing the bandwidth from 100MB to 500MB. Under this option, VCEDNET will assume the District's existing contract with Time Warner Cable for the internet circuit, with the net effect of increasing bandwidth five times over at little or no increase to the District's current cost for internet service. A copy of the proposed addendum is attached for the Board's information.
