2017-2018 Activities and Accomplishments

Snack Shack at home Football games: The Booster club does everything needed to run the snack shack at every home football game, including asking parents of other sports teams to work at the snack shack. The profit from the snack shack is one of the largest sources of funds for the Boosters general fund. General Booster funds are used to pay for, among other things, equipment for various sports teams and a portion of the sports trainer's salary and benefits.

Corporate Matching Donation program support: ABC increased its efforts towards pursuing corporate funds available to non-profit organizations like the Booster Club by informing parents of athletes about corporations that have community giving/matching programs. ABC gives 100% of matching funds received to the teams. During the 2016/2017 school year, fifteen families participated in the matching program raising \$5,200 for OPHS athletic programs. Companies like Amgen, Bank of America, Wells Fargo and many others have community giving/corporate matching programs.

Administrative support: Every sports team at OPHS raises funds to help support their sport. ABC holds money for many of the teams that collect money and disburses the funds as requested by the coaches and the athletic department administration. Donations made to your team through ABC qualify as tax deductions.

Scholarships to Graduating Seniors: ABC asks graduating seniors who have benefited from sports during their years at OPHS to apply for one of the two \$1,000 scholarships.
