**WHEREAS,** the Oak Park Unified School District Board of Education, at its regular meeting on January 16, 2018, approved the development and implementation of the Oak Park Unified School District Extended Care Program for child development services; and

**WHEREAS,** The California School Accounting Manual establishes Fund 12: Child Development Fund to be used to separately account for federal, state and local revenues to operate child development programs; and

WHEREAS, monies received by a Local Education Agency for, or from the operation of, child development services covered under the Child Care and Development Services Act (Education Code Section 8200 et seq.) shall be deposited into this fund; and

**WHEREAS,** costs incurred in the maintenance and operation of child development services shall be paid from this fund; and

WHEREAS, accounting for these funds will reflect specific funding sources per Education Code 8328;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Board of Education authorizes the Ventura County Superintendent of Schools to establish a Child Development Fund for the Oak Park Unified School District.
