The Superintendent, or designee, is directed to give notice of reduction/layoff to the affected classified employees pursuant to District rules and regulations, as well as the applicable provisions of the Education Code of the State of California, no later than sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of layoff, as set forth above.
- 4. The employees reduced or laid off pursuant to this Resolution shall be eligible for reemployment pursuant to Education Code section 45298.
