Notice posted November 30, 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Oak Park Unified School District Board of Education will hold its annual Organizational Meeting on December 15, 2020 at 6:00pm. The date of the organizational meeting was selected by the Board of Education at their November 17, 2020 regular meeting. Pursuant to Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20 in regard to the COVID-19 Pandemic, special procedures will be followed for this board meeting. The meeting will be conducted via teleconference/video conference.

Pursuant to *Education Code Section 35143*, the Governing Board of each School District must hold its 2020 Annual Organizational Meeting **between December 11 - 25, 2020** (inclusive).

Within 15 days prior to the date of the Annual Organizational Meeting, districts must notify in writing all members and members-elect of the date and time selected.

Per Education Code Section 5017, newly elected Board Members take office on the second Friday in December following certification of election - December 11, 2020.

Education Code section 5017 provides as follows:

Each person elected at a regular biennial governing board member election shall hold office for a term of four years commencing on the second Friday in December next succeeding his or her election. Any member of the governing board of a school district or community college district whose term has expired shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until his or her successor has qualified. The term of the successor shall begin upon the expiration of the term of his or her predecessor.

Government Code section 1360 provides as follows:

Unless otherwise provided, following any election or appointment and before any officer enters on the duties of his or her office, he or she shall take and subscribe the oath or affirmation set forth in Section 3 of Article XX of the Constitution of California.

Tina Wang and Denise Helfstein will be administered the Oath of Office at this meeting.
