

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

For Sufficiency of Textbooks and Instructional Materials

POSTED: September 8, 2017

As a condition of compliance with Education Code Section 60119 and California Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 9531c, local governing boards are required to hold an annual public hearing and adopt a resolution stating whether each pupil in the district has, or will have prior to the end of that year, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials in each subject consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board of Education consistent with the compliance regulations of the Williams Settlement.

Therefore, a public hearing regarding instructional materials sufficiency, for the 2017-2018 school year, will be held on September 19, 2017, at the regularly scheduled Board of Education meeting of the Oak Park Unified School District.
