- 5. Review Repeat courses:

 - b. If the course is repeated, but different levels such as Honors/AP/IB retaken in summer at the regular level include both grades
- 6. Grade scale is 4.0 with A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1 and F= 0; no extra points awarded for honors/AP or IB courses
